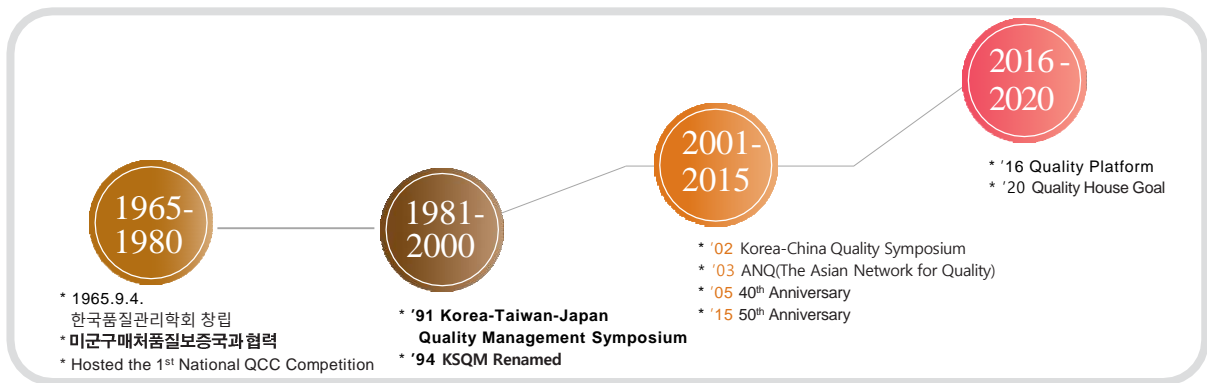

## Korea Quality Congress

KSQ is held twice a year regularly in spring and fall. Anyone interested in quality can participate conference without any restriction.

## ANQ Congress

The first AQS (The Asian Quality Symposium) was held in Seoul in 1987 mainly with Korea (KSQM) and Taiwan (CSQ) and in 1991, Japan (JSQC) participated in. AQS changed its name into ANQ (The Asian Network for Quality) in 2001 as participating countries expand across Asia. A total of 17 countries, Korea, Taiwan, Japan, China, Bangladesh, Dubai, Hong Kong, Kazakhstan, India, Iran, Indonesia, Nepal, Pakistan, Russia, Singapore, Thailand and Vietnam are participated in ANQ currently.

## The Korea-China Symposium on Quality

The Korea-China Symposium on Quality is an academic conference held in 2001 by Korean and Chinese Quality Management experts and managers. The conference is now held annually once a year under co-sponsorship of the Korea Science Foundation and China Science Foundation.

## Journal of Korean Society for Quality Management (JKSQM)

The Journal of Korean Society for Quality Management (JKSQM) promotes academic research on quality and advanced research to improve the quality competitiveness of enterprises and shares the studies.
